## Flowering Perennials



Asclepias speciosa (Showy Milkweed)
Prefers sun & little to moderate water. This
monarch host plant boasts other-worldly pink
flowers and wooly sage green leaves. Spreads by
rhizomes and can be cut to the ground when stalks
go dormant end of fall. Tolerates clay soil but
performs best with good drainage.

## Salvia 'Bee's Bliss'

Full sun & low water. Perfect as a ground cover or use to decoratively spill over a retaining wall. This pleasantly fragrant Salvia reaches 8ft wide to 8in tall and blooms in a copious display of lavender whorled flower stalks. And true to its name, Salvia 'Bees Bliss' is a bee, butterfly, and hummingbird magnet!

Lupinus arboreus (Yellow Bush Lupine)
Sun & low water. Found in CA coastal dune and
bluff habitat. The sweet fragrance of the 12" yellow
flower spikes will attract many pollinators and
human admirers. Readily reseeds itself, and seeds
that do not sprout make great forage for birds and
small mammals. It is also a host plant to many
native moths and butterflies.

Erigeron glaucus (Seaside Daisy)
Sun to partial shade & occasional to
moderate water. Found in coastal dune and
bluff habitat throughout the CA coast line,
this charming perennial daisy can create a
lush ground cover. Flowers almost year
round with some down time in the fall.
Prefers clay soils on steep slopes or sandy
soils on flat surfaces

**Penstemon heterophyllus** (Foothill Penstemon) Sun to part shade & low water. This electric blue and purple perennial is great for rock gardens and any dry areas that need an extra pop of color. Pair with White Sage or Cleveland Sage for a beautiful color contrast.

Salvia spathacea (Hummingbird Sage)
Full sun to shade & little to occasional water.
Found in oak woodland habitats, this plant
has spikes of fuchsia flowers that the
hummingbirds will fight over. It will spread by
rhizomes and create a nice groundcover.
The fruity fragrant leaves also make a
wonderful tea.

Philadelphus lewisii (Mock Orange)
Full sun to part shade & low water. This
northeastern, ~6'x6' shrub blooms early summer
and will be covered in clusters of highly fragrant,
orange blossom scented flowers. Prefers well
drained loamy/sandy soil. It is winter deciduous.

Clinopodium douglasii (Yerba Buena)
Part shade to shade & occasional water.
This durable groundcover requires little care
and does great on slopes. Perfect for
redwood gardens paired with Woodland
