### Flowering Perennials

	<p><b>Symphyotrichum chilense</b> (California Aster) Sun to part shade &amp; low to moderate water. A perfect perennial for pollinator and English style gardens. These purple daisy-like flowers will be a hit with your local butterflies and bees. Will readily reseed itself. Deadhead during the blooming season to produce more flowers. Can be cut back to the ground in winter. <b>TB5 \$4.95</b> (Wholesale \$3.25) <b>One Gallon \$9.95</b> (Wholesale \$4.95)</p>		<p><b>Achillea millefolium and cultivars!</b> We have Terra-cotta, Pink, Mellow-Yellow, Paprika, and Red Velvet Yarrow in stock! Sun to part shade &amp; low to moderate water. Yarrow has beautiful flower clusters and delicate lacy leaves. Grows 2-3 ft tall, spreads through rhizomes, and can create a ground cover. Encourage flowering by cutting back old flowers. Attracts a wide range of pollinators. <b>TB5 (white only) \$4.95</b> (Wholesale \$3.25) <b>One Gallon \$9.95</b> (Wholesale \$4.95)</p>
	<p><b>Asclepias fascicularis</b> (Narrow-leaf Milkweed) Full sun and little to moderate water, this narrow-leaf milkweed is a larval host plant that supports our local Santa Cruz monarchs! Be prepared to have your plant be eaten by monarch caterpillars but the reward will be the presence of beautiful monarch butterflies! It is crucial that no pesticides are used on this plant in order to protect the health of the monarchs. <b>TB5 \$6.95</b> (Wholesale \$4.95) <b>One Gallon \$11.95</b> (Wholesale \$6.95)</p>		<p><b>Salvia leucophylla 'Point Sal'</b> (Point Sal Purple Sage) Low water and low maintenance needs. This Salvia is a great option for a groundcover in full-sun or part-shade areas. This shrub has greyish-green leaves with lavender flowers that attract bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds. Can grow up to 3+ ft tall and up to 8 ft wide. <b>One Gallon \$13.95</b> (Wholesale \$9.95)</p>
	<p><b>Gambelia speciosa</b> (Island Snapdragon) Full sun to part shade and low moisture. This evergreen shrub under the right conditions can bloom almost year round. The red trumpet shaped flowers attract birds, especially hummingbirds. Easy to grow and does well in containers. Branches can get vine-like and can be trimmed back when too lengthy. <b>One Gallon \$9.95</b> (Wholesale \$4.95)</p>		<p><b>Iris douglasiana</b> (Douglas Iris) Sun to partial shade &amp; occasional to moderate water. Found in sunny coastal prairies to the redwood forest. Has strikingly large flowers that range from blue-ish purple to buttery yellow and attracts a wide range of pollinators. Will form spreading clumps of dark green leaf blades. Prefers heavy soil with organic matter. <b>One Gallon \$11.95</b> (Wholesale \$6.95)</p>
	<p><b>Heteromeles arbutifolia</b> (Christmas Berry, Toyon) Sun to part shade &amp; low water. Found in coastal sage scrub and chaparral habitat throughout California. This large evergreen shrub grows 10-15' tall with white flowers in the summer and bright red berry clusters in the winter. It is a great plant for attracting pollinators, wild birds, and creating a hedge. <b>One Gallon \$9.95</b> (Wholesale \$4.95)</p>		<p><b>Asarum caudatum</b> (Wild Ginger) Shade &amp; moderate water. Thrives under redwoods and found in wet woodlands by streams. It will spread by rhizomes and create a nice groundcover with unusual red-brown flowers hiding under the leaves. The heart-shaped leaves are aromatic with a spicy, gingery scent, growing in clusters up to 1 ft tall. <b>4" \$6.95</b> (Wholesale \$4.95) <b>One Gallon \$11.95</b> (Wholesale \$6.95)</p>
