Flowering Perennials

	<p>Ribes californicum (Hillside Gooseberry) This deciduous shrub prefers part shade when it is away from the coast and tends to grow in moist places. It grows to be 8 ft tall by 6 ft wide flowering in winter and spring. The flowers and the berries of this plant make it a valuable wildlife plant. Birds love the berries, and the flowers are very attractive to hummingbirds. One Gallon \$9.95 (Wholesale \$4.95)</p>		<p>Lupinus arboreus (Coastal Bush Lupine) Prefers full sun and fast draining soils, this evergreen shrub can reach 5 ft tall and 4 ft wide. Due to a symbiotic relationship with nitrogen assimilation bacteria in their roots, they help enrich the soil where they grow. It has very rapid growth with yellow flowers, great for pollinator gardens. DP40 \$13.95 (Wholesale \$9.95) One Gallon \$13.95 (Wholesale \$9.95)</p>
	<p>Ceanothus thyrsiflorus 'Yankee Point' (Yankee Point Blue Blossom) Full sun to part shade and low moisture. This evergreen shrub is used as a large scale groundcover that can reach up to 3 ft tall and 10 ft wide. The leaves are dark glossy green with fragrant bright blue flower clusters that attract the bees and butterflies. One Gallon \$11.95 (Wholesale \$6.95)</p>		<p>Festuca rubra "Molate" (Creeping Red Fescue) Tolerates full sun near the coast, but needs part shade to shade when inland. Grows best in sandy, coarse-grained or fast draining soil. Fast growing up to 2 ft. 	<p>Aesculus californica (California Buckeye) Part shade and full sun. This deciduous tree at full maturity can grow to a height of 39 ft tall by 40 ft wide. Native insects, including multiple butterfly species are attracted to the flowers that bloom in Summer and Spring. The flowers are a rich nectar source for butterflies and the seeds a food source for squirrels and chipmunks. Great for bank stabilization, hedges, and butterfly gardens. TP4 \$11.95 (Wholesale \$5.95)</p>		<p>Diplacus (Mimulus) aurantiacus (Sticky Monkey Flower) Part shade and full sun this evergreen sticky leaved subshrub can grow up to 5 ft tall and 5 ft wide. Their name comes from the flowers resembling the face of a monkey. The flowers are also tubular and commonly orange in color, pollinated by bees and hummingbirds. Tolerant of difficult soils as well as proper drainage is provided. TB5 \$4.95 (Wholesale \$3.25)</p>
	<p>Heteromeles arbutifolia (Christmas Berry, Toyon) Sun to part shade & low water. Found in coastal sage scrub and chaparral habitat throughout California. This large evergreen shrub grows 10-15 ft tall with white flowers in the summer and bright red berry clusters in the winter. It is a great plant for attracting pollinators and wild birds. One Gallon \$9.95 (Wholesale \$4.95)</p>		<p>Rosa californica (California Rose) Found in full sun to full shade areas. It is a deciduous thicket-forming shrub which could grow to 10 ft tall by 10 ft wide. The fragrant flowers appear in Summer and Spring, attracting bees, butterflies, and birds.
