Get ready for the rainy season now!

Get your seed, plant, and erosion control requests in before the October 15th regulatory deadline!

CCW Erosion Control Seed Mix \$120/bag

- 1.5lb bag covers ~ 1,000 sqft ~ Performs over a range of sun/dry to shade/moist.
- Seed mix of Elymus glaucus, Bromus carinatus, Hordeum brachyantherum, Festuca rubra 'Molate', Festuca microstachys, Trifolium wildenovii.
- Keep seeds moist in the ground for 2 weeks, or until germination.
- Plant now with irrigation or reserve and let nature water in the fall!



Aesculus californica (California Buckeye) 1 TP4 @ \$11.95

- Grows 17 to 39 feet tall
- Creates white flowers that bloom abundantly in spring
- Very low water needs
- Likes full sun

Quercus lobata (Valley Oak) 1 TP4 @ \$11.95

- Grows 45 to 84 feet tall!
- Provides large acorns for local wildlife
- Very low water needs
- Likes full sun or partial shade



Central Coast Wilds - October 2024 Highlights



Salvia spathacea (Hummingbird Sage) 1 Gallon @ \$19.95

- Beautiful flowers that attract pollinators, including hummingbirds!
- 1 to 3 feet tall, spreads via rhizomes
- Requires partial to full shade
- Low water needs

Symphoricarpos albus (Common Snowberry) 1 DP40 @ \$13.95

- 3 to 6 feet tall and 6ft wide at maturity
- Produces large white berries that are favored by birds
- Grows best in partial sun to full shade
- Spreads via rhizomes





Ribes sanguineum (Red Flowering Currant) 1 TB5 @ \$4.95

- Fast growing shrub with vibrant dark pink hanging flowers
- Grows 6-8 ft tall and 6-10 ft wide
- Does best in partial shade
- Creates dark purple berries that birds consume
