# **SEPTEMBER PLANT HIGHLIGHTS**

Get ready for the rainy season now! Get your seed, plant, and erosion control requests in well before the October 15th regulatory deadline!

#### CCW Erosion Control Seed Mix \$120/bag

- 1.5lb bag covers ~ 1,000 sqft ~ Performs over a range of sun/dry to shade/moist.
- Seed mix of Elymus glaucus, Bromus carinatus, Hordeum brachyantherum, Festuca rubra 'Molate', Festuca microstachys, Trifolium wildenovii.
- Keep seeds moist in the ground for 2 weeks, or until germination.
- Plant now with irrigation or reserve and let nature water in the fall!



Rosa Californica (California Rose) 1 DP40 @ \$9.95

- Grows about 6ft tall and 10 ft wide.
- Creates fragrant pink flowers that bloom abundantly during spring and summer.
- Does not need pruning to flower.
- Low water needs.

Vitis californica (California Wild Grape) 1 DP40 @ \$9.95

- Vining plant, will grow up to 30 feet long!
- Partial shade to full sun, will spread to reach sun.
- Fast grower.
- Moderate to low water.
- Produces small edible grapes in the fall.





## Euthamia occidentalis (Western Goldenrod) 1 TB5 @ \$4.95

- Full sun to partial shade.
- 4 to 6 feet tall, spreads via rhizomes.
- Can be used as erosion control and bank stabilization.
- Lives well in moist soil, such as by rivers or marshes.

### Phacelia californica (Rock Phacelia)

1 TB5 @ \$4.95

- 1 to 3 feet tall at maturity.
- Produces white to purple flowers during spring and summer.
- Fast growing.
- Grows best in full sun to partial shade.
- Attracts a butterfly endemic to Santa Cruz.





#### Arctostaphylos pilosula (La Panza Manzanita) 1 Gallon @ \$24.95

- Sun to partial shade & low water needs.
- Grows 3-6 ft tall and 3-6 ft wide.
- Spreading ground cover.
- Tolerant of poor soils.
- Creates small pink flowers that attract hummingbirds.
