Quercus lobata (Valley Oak) TP4 @ \$15.95

BUY 1 GET 2 SALE!!!

- 60-100 feet tall and 60-100 feet wide.
- Fast growing and the largest of all North American oaks.
- Endemic to California!
- Its large acorns attract many different kinds of birds.
- Can tolerate wildfires.





Phacelia californica (Rock Phacelia) 1 Gallon @ \$11.95

- 1-3 feet tall and 1-2 feet wide.
- It grows in chaparral, woodland, coastal bluffs, and grassland.
- Grows in full sun to part shade.
- Self-seeds and spreads easily.





Central Coast Wilds - April 2025 Highlights



Ribes viburnifolium (Catalina Currant) 1 Gallon @ \$15.95

- 2-3 feet tall and 8 feet wide.
- Prefers partial sun to shade and grows great under oaks.
- Dark green evergreen leaves.
- Stems root with contact to the ground.



Lilium pardalinum (Leopard Lily) 1 Gallon @ \$24.95

- 3-6 feet tall and 1 foot wide.
- Prefers partial shade and moist soil.
- Disease resistant and easy to grow.
- Grows from bulbs, and usually flowers in July.



Symphoricarpos albus (Snowberry) DP40 @ \$15.95 DP60 @ \$19.95

- 3-6 feet tall and 6 feet wide.
- Grows best in part shade to deep shade.
- Spreads via rhizomes.
- Winter deciduous with white berries in the fall.
- Loved by bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds.
