### Flowering Perennials

	<p><b>Fragaria chiloensis</b> (Beach Strawberry) Sun to part shade &amp; low water. A great sun loving groundcover with fast spreading runners. Its dark green leaves, red stems, and white flowers. Great as a lawn alternative for our coastal climate. Can handle a variety of soil conditions, but grows best in well draining soil. The strawberries are sweet but the critters always seem to find them first. <b>One Gallon \$9.95</b> (Wholesale \$4.95) <b>Tree Band \$4.95</b> (Wholesale \$3.25)</p>		<p><b>Fragaria vesca</b> (Woodland Strawberry) Part sun to shade &amp; low to moderate water. This is one of our favorite groundcovers for shady gardens. It spreads rapidly via runners, but won't overrun other plants due to its small stature. The berries are small, delicious, and plentiful but good luck getting to them before the critters do! <b>One Gallon \$9.95</b> (Wholesale \$4.95) <b>Tree Band \$4.95</b> (Wholesale \$3.25)</p>
	<p><b>Symphyotrichum chilense</b> (Beach Aster) Sun to part shade &amp; low to moderate water. A perfect perennial for pollinator and English style gardens. These purple daisy-like flowers will be a hit with your local butterflies and bees. Will readily reseed itself. Deadhead during blooming season to produce more flowers. Can be cut back to the ground in winter. <b>One Gallon \$9.95</b> (Wholesale \$4.95)</p>		<p><b>Phyla nodiflora</b> (Frog Fruit) Sun &amp; moderate water. This is a fast spreading ground cover that can be walked on and mowed like a lawn. It is often used as a lawn alternative or even mixed into an existing lawn to provide food for bees and butterflies. Its profuse flowers are a lovely shade of purple and white. Perfect for those who want to provide both habitat and a place for children and pets to play. <b>4" Pot \$4.95</b> (Wholesale \$3.25)</p>
	<p><b>Mimulus aurantiacus</b> (Sticky Monkeyflower) Sun to part shade &amp; low water. Found in a wide range of habitats with rocky or sandy hillsides, cliffs, and canyon slopes. This cantaloupe-colored flowering shrub is great for dry gardens and any areas that needs an extra pop of color. Attracts many native butterflies, bees and hummingbirds. Grows ~5'x5' max and can be pruned back by 50% in the late fall. <b>LT6 Cone \$5.95</b> (Wholesale \$3.95) <b>Tree Band \$11.95</b> (Wholesale \$5.95) <b>One Gallon \$9.95</b> (Wholesale \$4.95)</p>		<p><b>Penstemon eatonii</b> (Firecracker Penstemon) Sun &amp; low water. Great for pollinator gardens, attracting not only bees but also butterflies, and hummingbirds. This drought tolerant beauty would go great in a rock garden or with other low water needs plants like CA Sagebrush, CA Fuchsia, and Monkeyflower. <b>One Gallon \$9.95</b> (Wholesale \$4.95)</p>
	<p><b>Oxalis oregana</b> (Redwood Clover) Part shade to shade &amp; moderate water. Redwood Clover is often mixed with Woodland Strawberry for a lush carpeting groundcover. It spreads by rhizomes that can easily be dug up and planted around the garden. The tart, lemon-y flavored leaves are edible and can be added to salads. <b>One Gallon \$13.95</b> (Wholesale \$9.95)</p>		<p><b>Achillea millefolium</b> (Yarrow) Sun to part shade &amp; low to moderate water. Yarrow has beautiful white flower clusters and delicate lacy leaves. Grows ~2' tall, spreads through rhizomes, and can create a ground cover. Encourage flowering by cutting back old flowers. Attracts a wide range of pollinators. <b>LT6 Cone \$3.95</b> (Wholesale \$1.50) <b>Tree Band \$11.95</b> (Wholesale \$5.95) <b>One Gallon \$9.95</b> (Wholesale \$4.95)</p>
