Achillea millefolium (Common Yarrow) TB5 @ \$5.95

- 1 to 3 feet tall and 6-12 in wide
- Produces arrays of small white flowers, that attract pollinators
- Grows best in full sun to partial shade
- Spreads easily, creating ground cover





Woodwardia fimbriata (Giant Chain Fern) 4in pot @ \$10.95

- Grows 4 to 6 feet tall and wide at maturity
- Largest native fern in California!
- Low water needs
- Likes full to partial shade



Blechnum spicant (Deer fern) 1 Gallon @ \$15.95

- Grows 2-4 ft tall and 2 ft wide
- Deer resistant
- Needs shade, does well below trees
- Low water needs

Central Coast Wilds - November 2024 Highlights



Lupinus arboreus (Coastal Bush Lupine) 1 Gallon @ \$15.95

- Costal lupine with bright yellow flowers
- Very fast-growing, 4 to 6 feet tall at full maturity
- Requires full sun
- Low water needs
- Short-lived perennial that reseeds

Diplacus auranticus (Sticky Monkeyflower) 1 Gallon @ \$11.95

- 4 to 6 feet tall and 5ft wide at maturity
- Produces bright yellow and orange flowers that attract hummingbirds
- Grows best in full sun
- Evergreen with very low water needs





Iris douglasiana (Douglas Iris) 1 Gallon @ \$15.95

- Beautiful native iris with flowers ranging from white to dark blue
- Grows 12 30 inches tall and 2-4 ft wide
- Prefers part or full shade
- Deer resistant
- Traditional cordage plant
