Iris douglasiana (Douglas Iris) 4 inch @ \$10.95

- 1 to 2 feet tall and 2 to 4 feet wide.
- Can be grown in full sun to deep shade.
- Looks great in meadows or woodland gardens.
- Can handle drought, but prefers some soil moisture.
- Loved by caterpillars and butterflies.



Oenothera elata

(Hooker's Evening Primrose)

- 5 feet tall and 3 feet wide.
- It is tolerant of any soil type.
- Thrives in sun to part shade.
- Easy to grow and a prolific self seeder.
- Hosts over 15 different species of butterflies and moth.

Nemophila menziesii (Baby Blue Eyes) 4 inch @ \$8.95

- 6 inches tall and 6 inches wide.
- An easy to grow annual wildflower.
- Grows in full sun to part shade.
- Great for planting in between other perennials and shrubs.

Diplacus aurantiacus

(Sticky Monkey Flower)

- 3 to 5 feet tall and 2 to 4 feet wide.
- Prefers full sun in coastal areas and part shade in inland gardens.
- Deer resistant.
- Its long blooming season makes it a dependable nectar source for hummingbirds.

Woodwardia fimbriata

(Giant Chain Fern)

4 inch @ \$10.95 1 Gallon @ \$15.95

- 4 to 6 feet tall and 4 to 6 feet wide.
- Largest fern in North America.
- Prefers part shade to full shade.
- Looks great as an accent plant in a woodland garden.



Eriogonum parvifolium

(Seacliff Buckwheat)

- 1 to 3 feet tall and 2 to 3 feet wide.
- Can be used for erosion control, and looks great in rock gardens.
