

*Ranunculus californicus*  
(buttercup)

- One of our first spring bloomers, there's no better way to start the season than gazing upon fields of bright yellow shiny flowers!
- Best suited for a sunny plot and requiring minimal water once established, these perennial herbs support the early-season native bees.



*Sidalcea malviflora*  
(checker bloom)

- Adorned with the sweetest pink flowers, this fast growing plant will thrive in full sun or partial shade, and do well in a variety of soil types.
- Plant alongside other lower-growing natives, and enjoy a pop of pink in your garden this spring!

*Erigeron glaucus*  
(seaside daisy)

TB5 @ \$7.95, 1G @ \$11.95

- Dainty and classic, this mounding daisy that you may have seen growing along the coast makes a hardy and dependable garden addition.
- Use as a groundcover, or plant among bunch grasses for variety!



*Phacelia californica*  
(California phacelia)

TB5 @ 7.95

- This borage family plant owes its long bloom period to the series of unraveling curls that travel up their long stems. Expect blooms as early as late February and all the way into August!
- Bees can't get enough of this one (proof below), and once established you'll have a consistent early bloomer that self seeds and comes back year after year!
